i-Ready Testing:

Our new benchmarking system for students in grades K-8 is i-Ready. This system replaces MI and RI which were used by our district for the last several years. i-Ready provides an assessment of where a student is at a given point in the school year in the areas of math and reading. The program also allows our teachers to pinpoint to access interventions when they may need an extra boost in math or reading. Finally, the program has a monitoring system that checks if the interventions are effective. We began benchmark testing this week and we will conclude in early September.
