This application must be approved before a non-school related group is allowed to use school facilities. School organizations, school-sponsored programs, and organizations whose primary purpose is to provide financial assistance to the school are all considered, for the purpose of this application, to be school-related. Use of school facilities for school purposes has precedence over all other uses.

Sufficient, competent adult supervision must be provided and the adult supervisor must ensure that no minor is left alone after the activity. Only the cafeteria, anditorium, gymnasium, and athletic field, along with needed hallways and parking areas, are available for community use. Entering any room or area not in use by the group is prohibited. The adult supervisor will vacate the facility at the scheduled end time. Use of the school facility is not permitted past the agreed end time. No furniture or equipment may be moved without prior approval from the Building Principal. Signs, displays, or materials may not be attached, nailed, or otherwise affixed to walls.

Pay any damages to school facilities, furniture, or equipment arising out of its use of school property whether such damage was accidental or deliberate. Category A— School Affiliated, Youth Oriented, Local Professional Educator Organizations, After School Campus Registered Student Clubs, School Camps, Non-Profit Groups such as PTO, PTSO, Booster Clubs.

OR

Category B— Non School Affiliated Events, Youth Oriented, Non-Profit, Sport Clubs. Examples: Youth Sports Associations, Youth Sports Clubs, Non-City of Girard or Virden programs, North Mac Sanctioned Programs which benefit North Mac Students.

Fees: Building fees/utilities for these groups will be waived during the school week only (Monday-Thursday). Fees will apply for personnel and facility use (as needed) and use of equipment in specialized areas of each facility. Usage of special equipment requires authorization from the building principal or designee. Building fees/utilities for these groups may also be waived during weekends (Friday-Sunday) if prior arrangements for supervision and cleanup are arranged with the building principal.

Facility Fee: Gyms - \$30/hour

Cafeterias - \$30/hour Commons - \$30/hour Classroom - \$30/hour

Custodial Support - \$25hr/per person (2 hour minimum)
Certified Staff Supervisor - \$31hr/per person
Technicians - \$27hr/per person
Maintenance - \$30 base fee (2 hour minimum)
Kitchen Supervisor - \$25hr/per person

Category C— Non-Youth Oriented, Non-Profit Groups (must be able to provide a 501 (c) if needed), Outside Organizations.

Examples: Churches, Civic Organizations, Government Entities, Homeowners Associations

Fees (Utilities included): based on a three-hour block.

Facility Fee: Gyms - \$125/hour

Cafeterias - \$75/hour Commons - \$50/hour Classroom - \$50/hour

Custodial Support - \$25hr/per person (2 hour minimum) Certified Staff Supervisor - \$31hr/per person Technicians - \$27hr/per person Maintenance - \$30 base fee (2 hour minimum) Kitchen Supervisor - \$25hr/per person

Category D— Profit Groups such as Local Businesses and any group without a non-profit status. Outside Organizations.

Examples: Dance Companies, Daycare Centers, private businesses, etc.

Fees (Utilities included): based on a three-hour block.

Facility Fee: Gyms - \$200/hour

Cafeterias - \$125/hour Commons - \$80/hour Classroom - \$80/hour

Custodial Support - \$25hr/per person (2 hour minimum)
Certified Staff Supervisor - \$31hr/per person
Technicians - \$27hr/per person
Maintenance - \$30 base fee (2 hour minimum)
Kitchen Supervisor - \$25hr/per person
