A Look at This Month...

October

Journey (Language Arts - Reading & Writing): We are working through the alphabet, naming a letter each day. Soon we will be learning letter sounds. We have learned the site words I and like and will be adding two to three new site words each week this month. We have started writing our letters and site words and reading in small groups. We are learning how to recognize and make rhymes, naming first word sounds and naming nouns for people and places. Please practice naming letters and site words each night. Also, don't forget to read to your child daily/nightly.

McGraw (Math): We are finishing up Unit 1 (numbers 1-5) and will have our first unit test on Thursday October 3. Next, we will begin Chapter 2 (numbers 1-10).
