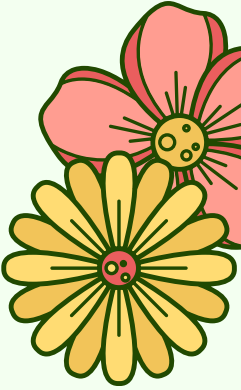

Softball has a road game vs. Tri City at 4:30. The bus leaves at 2:40

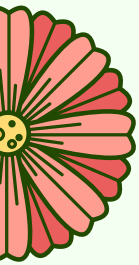

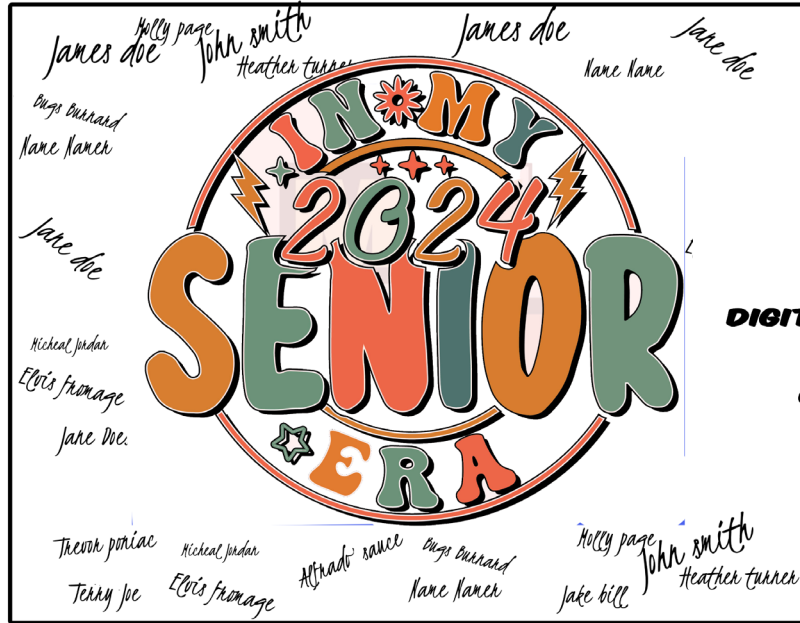



There will be a meeting today in the cafeteria during pod for any boys interested in playing basketball next year.

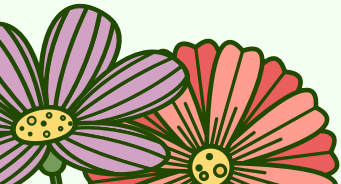
