## Mr. Eldridge's Rules & Expectations

- Respect yourself, others, and school property.
- Always be prepared for class. Always bring your textbook, your notebook, your folder, and writing utensils. You must have a pencil, a blue or black pen, and a red pen. A red pen may be used for grading only. Bring all these items unless I have instructed you not to do so. If you do not bring all materials to class you will receive a lack. Three lacks are allowed per quarter, but the fourth will be a detention.
- Be inside the classroom door when the bell rings. If you are not inside the classroom door you are considered tardy. Three tardies are allowed per quarter, but the fourth will result in a detention.
- Turn assignments in on time. Assignments that are not turned in on time will be accepted if completed the next day for half credit. Otherwise, it is a zero, which could considerably hurt your grade. Make up work is the only exception to the late work policy.
- Candy, gum, and soda will not be allowed in my classroom.
- Raise your hand to speak.
- Three bathroom breaks will be allowed per quarter.
- If students choose not to follow the rules, they will be given a warning and then a detention.
