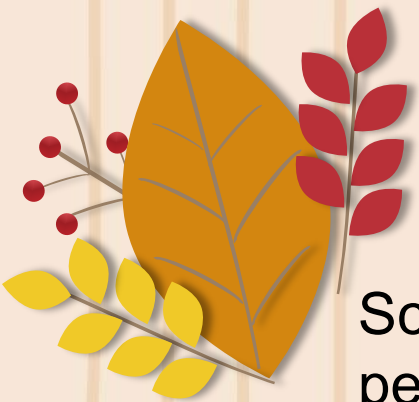

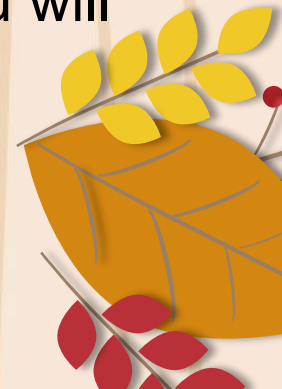
-This Friday, November 10th, wear red, white, and blue to honor Veterans and their service.
