Fritz Pollard was small, but he loved football and went on to have a historic football career at Brown University. Many firsts were ahead of him, starting with being the first Black player to be selected for the Walter Camp All-American team and play in the Rose Bowl.

He went on to join the American Professional Football League- which later became the NFL. He became the first Black coach and led the team to their first title.
