The Importance of Pre-K Education –Pre-School is a way for children to learn how to build, create, problem solve, cooperate, communicate, enjoy activities, learn diversity, build self-esteem and be a part of a loving community—where all are accepted. It's so much more than just singing songs and playing. Singing songs encourages speech and language development, enhancing vocabulary and communication skills. Students who struggle with a certain skill (ABCs, counting or math patterns) are able to show mastery through learning a song about it. Also, playing games is the perfect opportunity for kids of this age to express their curiosity, learn teamwork, practice sharing and develop problem-solving skills. If you have a student, or know of one that will be turning age 3 by September 1, 2021, please consider calling Mrs. Earley (information listed below) to make an appointment during our Pre-K Screening days. She will be happy to help you with any questions you might have.

<u>Agriculture Field Day</u> – The High School Agriculture Department has kindly invited our Elementary students over to enjoy Ag Field Day on May 14<sup>th</sup>. This is a day when the High School students get to help teach the littles about all of the various aspects of farming, raising animals, soil care, clean water and many other aspects.
